1. Overview

- 1.1 In managing the return of staff and students to campus, the University will ensure that it continues to provide a safe environment for people to work and study and that appropriate measures are in place to support compliance with Government guidance.
- 1.2 As part of that, the University will need to collect and process personal data about staff, students and third parties, including health data. This includes the data we collect in our Covid Reporting Application, for example, relating to individuals who are self-isolating as a result of a positive test, Covid-19 related symptoms, or contact with an individual with Covid-19.
